- Pursuing a degree in accountancy
- Completion of **no more than two accounting courses by summer 2018** for **Launch to Success** (students that have not completed an accounting course are eligible to apply)
- Completion of a **minimum of three accounting courses by summer 2018** for **Sights on Success**
- Current cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher; 3.2 or higher in any accounting courses
